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VERMONT STATE COLLEGES SYSTEM OVERVIEW

The VSCS is currently undergoing a significant transformation, with the guidance of the Governor, Legislature, the Board of Trustees and the State's Select Committee on the Future of Public Higher Education in Vermont. The VSCS beganworking on internal transformation in summer 2020 with the VSCS Forward Task Force and several institutional tasks forces including NVU Strong and VTC's Transformation Advisory Team.

The <u>Vermont State Colleges Syst</u>(WSCS) is comprised of two member institutions – <u>Community College of Vermon</u>(CCV) and VermontStateUniversity(VTSU). The system educates over ten thousand Vermonters and when monters each year, employs over three thousand/ermonters and Spring 2020 graduated overeighteen hundred Vermonters and out-of-state students into the workforce with certificates decapted.

 - a. Being the entry location for an annumalmpus crossountry race
 - b. Sales of apples texternal organizations artners
 - c. Access to the orchard for alumni day events
 - d. Sale of VTSURandolph maple syrup at the farm shed during bla-season
 - e. VTSU student, faculty and staff discounds apples
- 3. Willingness and qualification to provide instruction (e.g., lead tours, serve as a guest lecturer or provide support in areas of orchard management (e.g., pest management, production systems, pruning, marketing);
- 4. Openness to taking on VTSU student intermed;
- 5. Retaining a community function to the orchard, including education and exposure of the public to a quality orchard experience, collaborations with local foodbanks for donations, outreach with schools, etc.
